**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** - The Stations of the Cross will be held on the 11th day of Lent at 11:30 am. All are welcome.

**LENTEN ABSTINENCE** - The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. With regard to the obligation listed above, there is frequent confusion about the matter. The teaching of the Holy Father may be simply paraphrased; the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially," is penitential. No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe is considered serious. People should seek to do more rather than less. A minimum response to the Lord's call to penance should be considered a minimum response to the Lord's call to penance.

The statement called for replacing clericalism with a "culture of conversion" in the Church.
